- Only touch your pot on the wheel when it is spinning! - Pick your greenware up with two hands

Be patient!

and from the bottom, never by the rim.

Nails can hurt, get a manicure!

- Rushing is the surest way to ruin it! - Trimming too wet or too dry is asking for trouble...
- Wipe well (+ dry) before glazing. - Test thickness before you trim.
