
So, we hope you can join us this Friday, October 15th, 6-9pm at Oktoberfest 2010.



Sunday One-Day Workshops | Ages 5 and up

After making a pot, it is important to "slow dry" your piece so that the water from the clay evaporates at an even rate and your piece doesn't break apart. To do this, we

use plastic. If your piece has attachments, wrap your piece completely to create a sealed environment to allow no moisture to escape and the pieces of uneven moisture to even

drying. Be aware that humidity and the heat from the pipes in the studio can seriously alter the length of time something takes to dry,

leave partially open to promote a slow, even

If there are no attachments (e.g. a bowl),

so monitor your work regularly... And make sure to put your name and the date on anything you are placing on the shelves.

Try not to put plastic directly on sticky, just thrown clay. Place a small piece of newspaper on the open end under the plastic, if necessary, to avoid the plastic

dragging or distorting the clay. At the studio, it is important to put your name and the date on anything you are placing on the shelves with a piece of masking tape.

dust is unhealthy...this helps you and helps us to keep the studio clean.

While La Mano is "all about recycling": if the plastic is dusty, throw it out. Clay
