In the Gallery

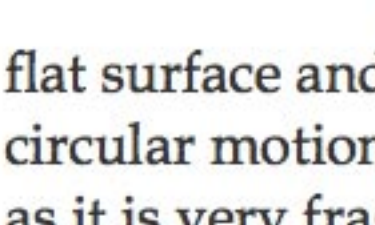
Oktoberfest was a total success! We sold 110 mugs and the studio was full of good cheer with everyone drinking out of ceramic mugs, each one different and unique.

Potter's Tip of the Month



Even It Out

Is your pot uneven or wobbly? Before being bisqued, this can be fixed with a simple trick-of-the-trade. With a sponge, wet an area on a flat surface and rub the bottom of your pot around in a circular motion on the damp surface (cradling the pot gently, as it is very fragile at this state). Voila!
